### - Superintendent's Corner -

### When Will the Courses Open?

When will the golf courses open in 2023? We wait until the frost is out of the greens and the threat of multiple deep freezes has subsided, typically around March 15th. We have opened as early as February 15th (1977) and as late as April 12 (1983). In 2022 we opened on March 16th. Please watch the website for updated opening information, *villagelinksgolf.com*.

#### Greens Aeration Plans

In an effort to create firm, smooth, healthy greens aeration is a necessary evil. With soil testing we can determine our Organic Matter levels and choose the right program to achieve our goals. This spring we will again forego aerification as we are achieving great results with our fall aerification and heavy winter topdressing. We make every effort to minimize surface disruption during the season and we continuously monitor performance and will return to both spring and fall aerification if needed.

### Ball Mark and Divot Repair

This is a friendly reminder that it is the responsibility of every golfer to do their part to leave the golf course better than you found it. The easiest way to achieve this is by repairing ball marks on the greens and filling or replacing divots on Tees and Fairways. Visit <code>villagelinksgolf.com/course-repair</code> for a great tutorial from the USGA. Now for divot repair, the big question is whether to replace the divot or fill it with sand. Simply if the divot is intact and has soil attached, replace it, step it down flat and carry on. If it breaks apart or you are unable to find it, fill the divot with sand and smooth it with your foot. With these simple steps you can help your maintenance team as well as your fellow golfers.

### Future Facility Improvements

We are excited to announce some facility and clubhouse improvements are planned to begin shortly. Please "pardon our dust" as we prepare to refresh the halfway house and golf shop, including the men's and women's golf restrooms and adjoining hallway. The renovations are expected to begin this Spring.

In addition, this past summer, the Village Links of Glen Ellyn hired Greg Martin of Martin Design Golf to develop a Master Plan for our 27-hole golf course. Village Links staff has identified areas we would like to address such as bunkers, expanding par 3 tee sizes, drainage and cart paths. Greg has been on-site multiple times and has worked closely with Certified Golf Course Superintendent Andrew Cross to put together his first draft for staff review. We will continue to provide updates as we develop the Master Plan and any strategies necessary to minimize disruption to our operations.



### 2023 Half-Day & All-Day Junior Golf Camps

Juniors can choose from 33 All-Day Junior Golf Camps in 2023. The morning instruction segment of each camp includes a visit to multiple learning stations to cover every aspect of the game. After a supervised lunch, the juniors play the 9-hole course. Instruction is tailored to the progress of each individual, allowing juniors to sign up for multiple camps. The \$89 camp fee includes instruction, lunch, and a supervised 9-holes of golf.

44 Half-Day Junior Golf Camps are geared towards boys and girls with little or no golf experience. The \$59 fee includes concentrated instruction, fun activities that complement and nurture fundamental skills, and a certificate for free nine holes of golf (restrictions apply). Morning and afternoon sessions are available.

#### Who qualifies for a Resident Card?

Applicants must reside within the corporate limits of the Village of Glen Ellyn. Apply in person at the Golf Shop to have your photo taken. Proof of residency is required. Resident Cards must be renewed annually and expire on December 31.

#### What are the benefits of a Resident Card?

Resident Card holders receive discounts on their green fees, and receive preferred access to tee time reservations. You can use your "Village Links Card" immediately.

#### Why should I apply for my Resident Card now?

Adult Resident Cards are \$10 before March 15 and \$20 thereafter. Junior Cards are \$5 and \$10 after March 15. Cards must be renewed annually and expire on December 31.

The World Handicap System in association with the USGA is available through membership in the Chicago District Golf Association for an annual fee of \$50, or \$40 if you participate in their auto-renewal program. Handicaps are used in most Village Links competitions and enable golfers of varied abilities to compete on an equitable basis. Village Links handicaps may only be purchased or renewed online through cdga.org.

### Multi-Play Resident Discount Rounds

As an additional benefit, multi-play purchasers can bring up to three accompanied guests to play at the resident rate. Some restrictions apply. Multi-play purchasers may play free with a family member after 5:30 p.m. every day.
